3 Lessons Passed:

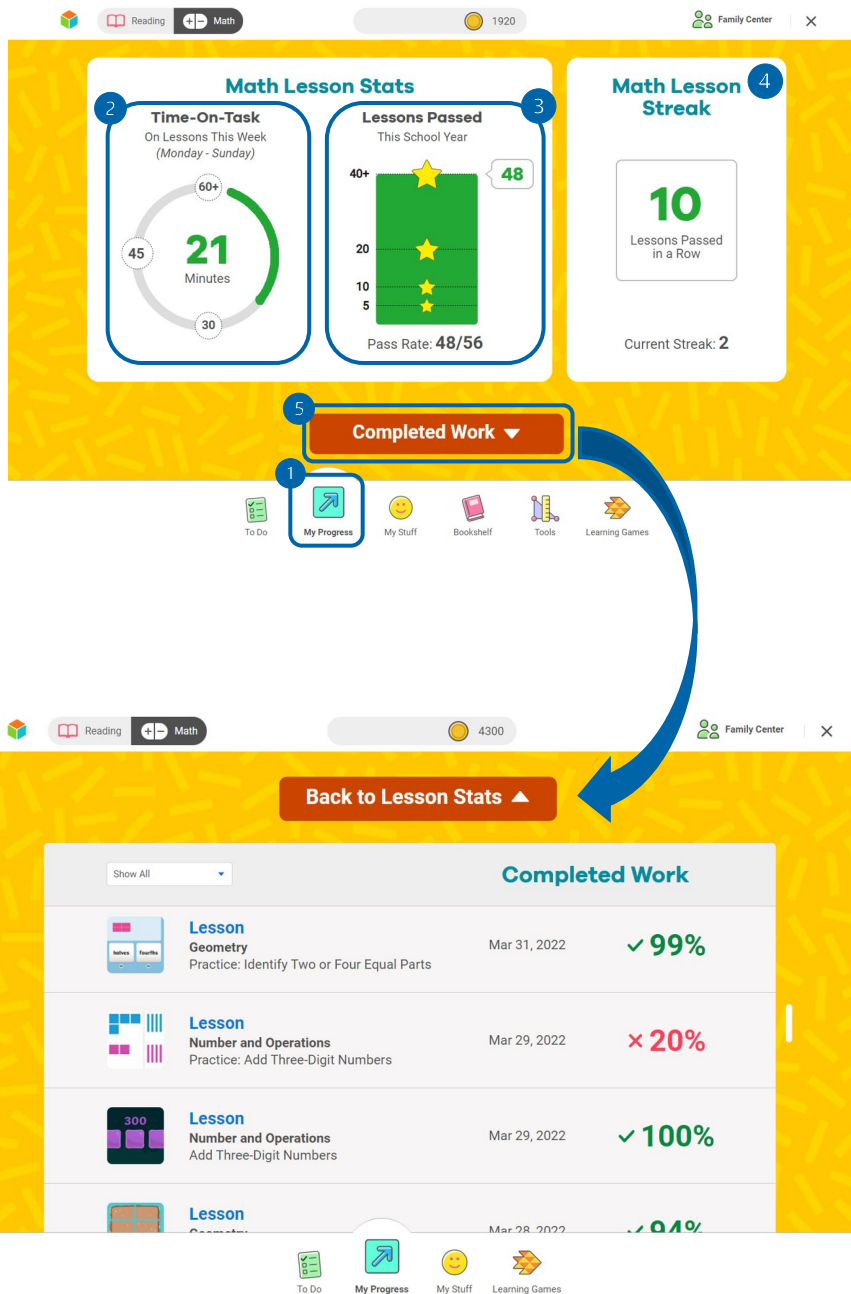

1. To access the Clever portal directly, students can go to <https://www.clever.com> and select "Log in as Student."

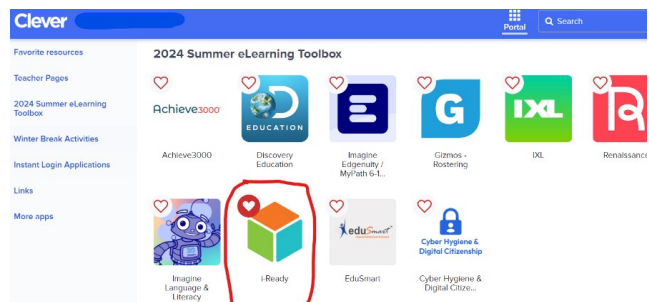

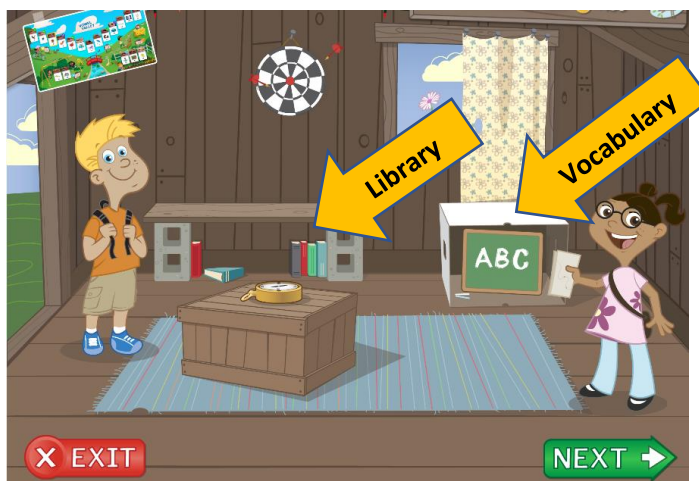




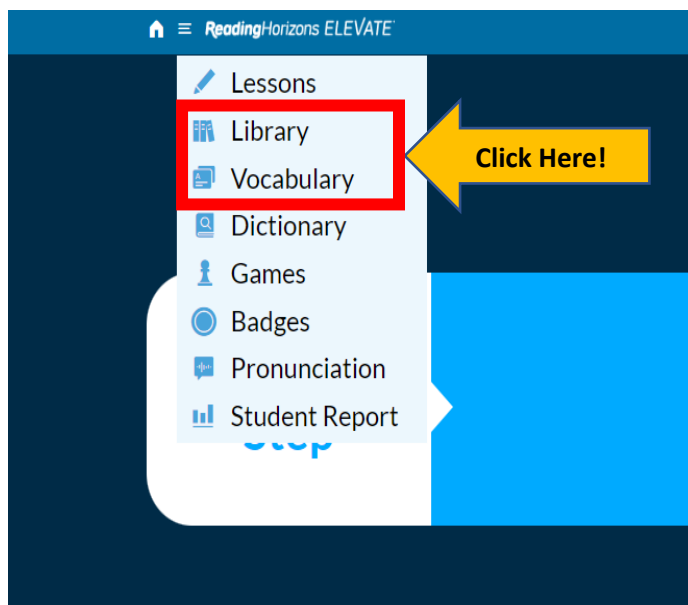
Reading Horizons Summer Access
